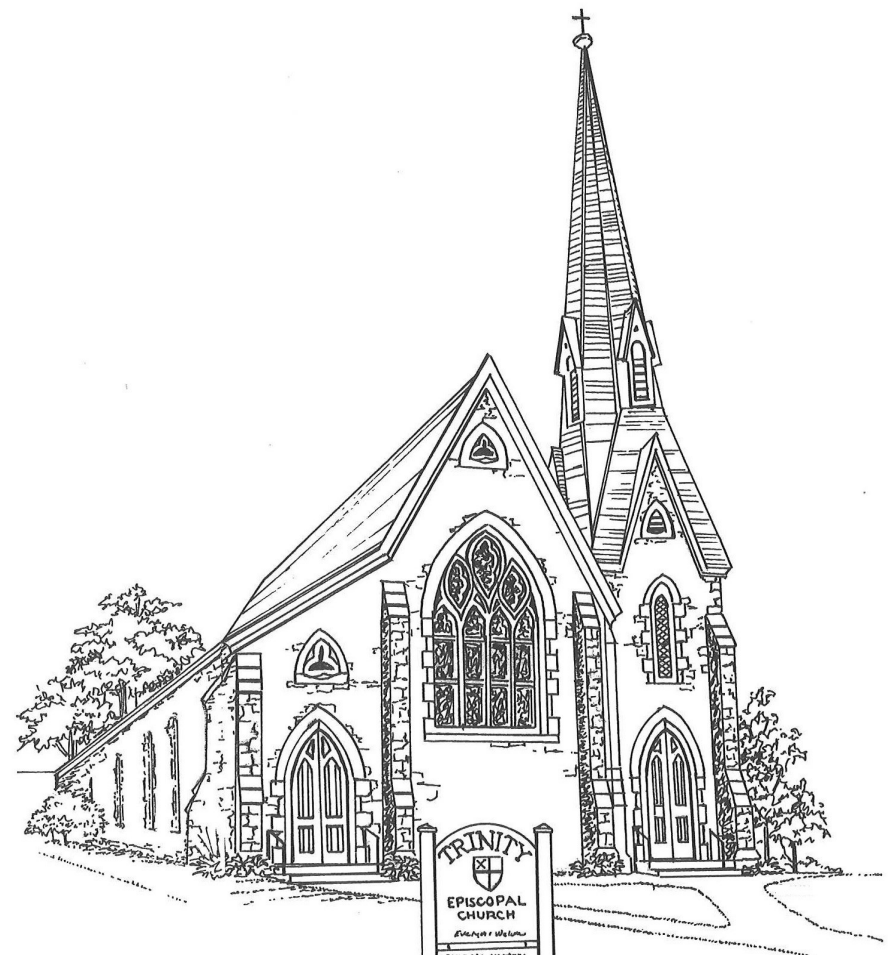


## TRINITY CHURCH ANNOUNCEMENTS
