(Until we see His face let us prepare the way)

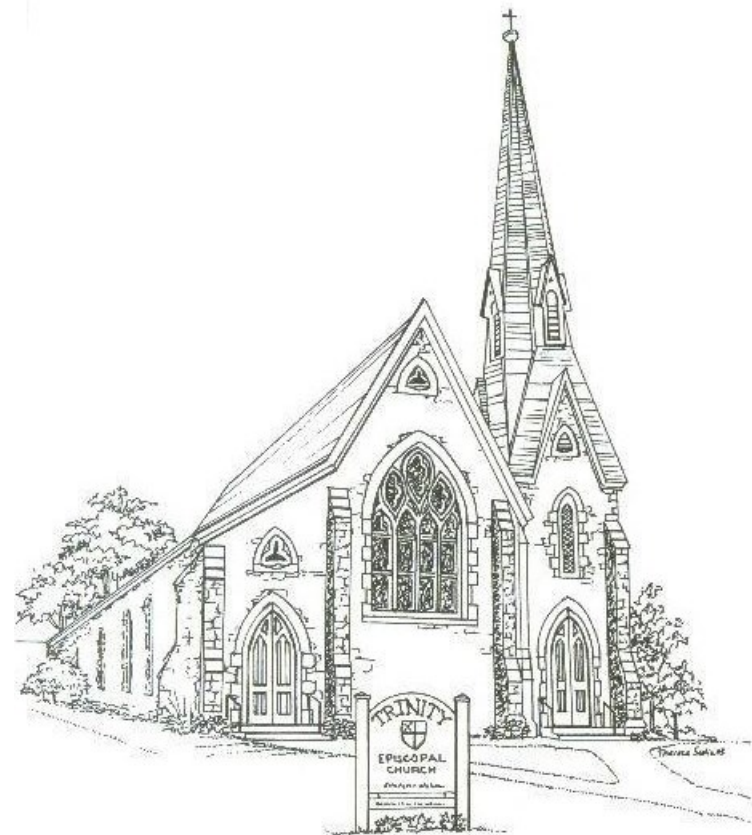
